GOVERNOR TO VISIT BALLARAT'S TRIPLE ZERO CENTRE

The Governor of Victoria, the Honourable Linda Dessau AC, will visit the Emergency Services Telecommunications Authority's (ESTA) Ballarat centre on Friday 1 February.

- **What:** Governor of Victoria to visit ESTA's Ballarat State Emergency Communications Centre.
- **When:** Friday 1 February 2019.
- **Time:** 10:45am – 11:45am.
- **Where:** Ballarat State Emergency Communications Centre, 15 Enterprise Grove, Mt Helen.

The Governor is visiting in her capacity as Patron of the 10-Year Anniversary of the 2009 Victorian Bushfires.

The Governor and her husband, Mr Anthony Howard QC, will tour the triple zero centre, which is one of three in the state that provide emergency call-taking and dispatch for Victoria's police, fire, ambulance and SES services.

ESTA's CEO, Marty Smyth and the Ballarat centre's Executive Manager of Operations, Anthony Rasmussen, will meet the Governor and Mr Howard and arrange a 'plug-in' in which the Governor can listen to an operator answer real-time triple zero calls.
